

## RULES FOR AUTHORS OF THE BULLETIN OF FISHERIES SCIENCE JOURNAL

The Bulletin of Fisheries Science scientific journal publishes original articles on "inland water fisheries research." Articles on the following subjects are accepted: taxonomy, biology, physiology, genetics, anatomy, faunistics and zoogeography of aquatic organisms; diseases of aquatic organisms; the state of stocks; ecology of populations and communities; artificial reproduction and commodity cultivation of fish; technological aspects of aquaculture; aquaculture marketing problems; feed production; ecology of fishery waters; aquatic toxicology; human impact on aquatic organisms and the ecosystem; protection of water and aquatic ecosystems; fisheries research methodology; production technology of commodity food products.

The journal includes the following topics: "Biological resources", "Ecology", "Parasitology", "Fisheries and aquaculture".

The journal accepts for publication articles in the Russian and English languages. A prerequisite for publishing is substantiation of the relevance, novelty and importance of the presented material.

The journal is included in the Russian Science Citation Index (RISC) and places full texts of the articles on the SEL website ([www.elibrary.ru](http://www.elibrary.ru)), in this regard, in accordance with Part IV of the Civil Code of the Russian Federation the founder concludes a licensing agreement with the author of the article for the right to use the scientific work in the journal.

articles of post-graduates are not charged.

### Rules of preparation of the materials

1. The original article must be signed by all the authors mentioned in the paper. The authors must guarantee (in writing) that the materials sent were not previously published anywhere and were not accepted for publication in other editions.

2. The article must be accompanied by the authorization of the head of the institution, organization for publication. The organization sending the paper as well as the author is liable for its scientific content, reliability and originality of the data given.

3. The articles are reviewed by experts in the field of fisheries research. The Editorial Board has the right to return the materials to the author for rework. In this regard, please send a well edited and thoroughly checked materials. . The Editorial Board reserve the right to make cuts or stylistic changes of the text which do not affect the content of the article without the consent of the author (s).

4. The manuscript should be submitted in two copies (one printed and the other one in electronic form). 5. The paper should not exceed 20 pages, including references, tables and figures. The volume of short communications should not exceed 5 pages. The number figures in the article should not exceed six.

### Structure and content of the articles

1. Article Index UDC (left).

2. Title of the article (in capital letters).

3. Initials and surnames of the authors.

4. Name of the institution in which the authors work.

5. Address (country, city).

6. Summary (recommended volume of 1,000-2,000 characters with spaces (200-250 words) for short communications - 500-850 characters) without breaking down into paragraphs. The abstract reflects the structure and content of the article, the basic factual information and conclusions, without additional interpretations or critical comments of the author. It must not contain the description of the previously published works, well-known ideas, information on the status of the problems, relevance of the research performed. It is allowed to se abbreviations within the abstract (concept notion of two or

three words is replaced with an abbreviation of the corresponding number of letters, the first time it should be given in full with the abbreviation in brackets, then the abbreviation only is used).

Requirements to the English translation of the abstract. Never use machine translation! A full point is used instead of a decimal comma. All Russian abbreviations are to be given in a deciphered form if they do not have stable analogues in English.

7. Key words (no more than 8) are separated from each other with a semicolon.

8. The text of the article with illustrative material (tables, figures).

The text should have the following sections: "Introduction", "Materials and research methods", "Results of the study", "Discussion of Results", "Summary", "References", but another structure is acceptable if it corresponds to the specifics of the particular, provided it has a limited volume and clear titles of the sections.

9. The references to the sources in the text are given in square brackets, in the order of citation in the text. No references to unpublished works are allowed (for example, research report). The titles of monographs, collected works and journals are to be given in full. For reference to the data obtained from the Internet the electronic address of the primary source of information is to be given. Information about the cited sources is to be given in accordance with GOST R 7.0.5-2008:

a) for books, monographs, textbooks and manuals: the author's surname, initials, full name of the source, place of publication, year of publication;

b) for journal articles and other periodicals: the author's surname, initials, title of the paper, full or generally accepted abbreviated title of the journal, year of publication, volume number, issue (date - for a newspaper);

c) to collections of scientific articles and conference proceedings: the authors' surname and initials, the title of his particular work, full name of the source (collection), place of publication, year of publication.

Making References. We propose the following order of description of the literary source IC (visual style - Vancouver): authors (transliteration); translation of the article title into English in square brackets; the name of the Russian-speaking source in English - paraphrase (you are allowed not to do for journals); dateline with designation in English; indication of the language of the article (In Russ.) after the description of the article. On the site <http://translit.ru/> you can make free use of transliteration of a Russian text in Latin (BSI format).

10. In English you are to give the title of the article title, authors' initials and surnames (transliteration), place of work, e-mail address, abstract, keywords.

11. About the authors: surname, name, patronymic (in full); academic degree; place of work (full name of the institution where the author works in the nominative case with obligatory statement of the legal status of the organization (abbreviation before the name); position; postal address of the place of work (postal code, country, city, street, house number); contact phone numbers, e-mail address.

12. Date of receipt of the article by the editor. The date of delivery of the article shall be the date of receipt of its final version by the Editorial Board.

#### Specifications for the text content

1. The electronic version of the article is typed in Microsoft Word. Observe the margins: top, bottom, left - 2.5 cm, right - 1.5 cm Font: Times New Roman, size 12, half interval.. All pages in the article should be numbered in the upper right corner.

2. Latin names of organisms that are used in the text are given in accordance with the modern classification in italics. The first mention should state the full name of the organism - generic and specific, for example: *Coregonus tugun*, *Cottocomephorus grewingki* (Dybowski, 1876). Further mention of the generic name is abbreviated to the first capital letter, for example: *C. tugun*, *C. grewingki*. Names of families are written completely.

3. Units of measurement are typed like an ordinary text rather than formulas.

4. Formulas are typed in Microsoft Equation (or MathType) formular editor and saved so as to be able to edit them (no pictures!).

5. Drawings, photographs, charts, diagrams are to be presented as integrated into the text in Word editor and duplicated in jpg or tif - for raster graphics (photographs, drawings). Charts, graphs made in Excel, Statistica, or other compatible package MS Office applications are submitted in separate files (in eps format, charts - in xls format). No frames around the image, including charts and chart legends, are allowed.

6. Authors should take into account that the journal does not provide for color print, so figures should be black and white.
